Cat Spay/Neuter Clinic

The Humane Society of Morrow County will hold six low cost CAT spay/neuter clinics in 2025.

The dates of the clinics are Thursdays:

January 16	March 13	May 8
July 10	September 11	November 13

and the location is the Big Walnut Joint Fire District in Marengo.

The cost is \$50 per cat, and includes the spay or neuter and a rabies vaccine. Additional vaccinations and other services are available for additional fees. We will register a total of 50 cats for each clinic. The clinics fill up, so we encourage you to register early to ensure your spot. There is no limit to the number of cats per individual. Feral cats are accepted. Rescues or similar groups cannot be accommodated during these clinics.

The registration process begins thirty days before each clinic, with in-person and email registrations provided. Registration must be made directly through the HSofMC along with payment to secure your spot. The opening of the registration process and the in-person registration dates will be announced on our Facebook page.

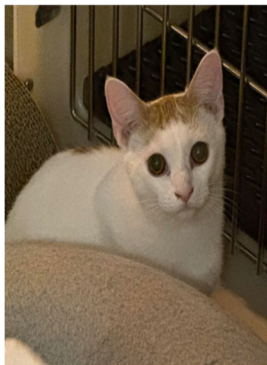
